As a niche sport, American Football in the UAE offers a unique experience for its players, coaches, officials, and parents. In the EAFL, we encounter many challenging circumstances when compared to football in the USA or Canada, including:

- fewer players, coaches, and officials
- less experienced players
- less exposure to football, in general
- expat travel schedules
- extreme heat

Despite the challenges, the EAFL has become an award-winning amateur youth sports program.

To counteract some of these challenges, the EAFL has adopted the USA Football methodology and rulebooks which provides a framework for players new to the sport. The USA Football Rookie Tackle format uses the National Federation of High Schools (NFHS) Football rule book as a base and employs a number of adjustments for various football formats from 6-man to 8-man.

The EAFL further adjusts this rulebook to accommodate our players in each division. For instance, some features of NFHS Football are added back in for the Bantam and Varsity Divisions in an effort to make the game more authentic. For PeeWee, the rulebook is mostly the same as USA Football Rookie Tackle.
